

Life Group Discussion Material - Sunday, March 7th Message

<p>What in the World is Going On? (Psalm 2) <i>Answers for Today from the Old Testament</i></p>

1. How many times in the last year have you asked yourself, “what in the world is going on?”
2. In reference to this past year’s craziness; do you tend to get caught up in everything going on and let it cause despair, do you tend to bury your head and ignore everything, or do you do well at finding balance?
3. *Why do the nations rage* as expressed in Psalm 2:1? Who or what are they raging against?
4. Read Psalm 2:3. Before you came to faith in Christ, can you see how you were self-determined to *burst the bonds apart* and be free from *the cords* of God’s rule in your own life? How did that work out for you?
5. Discuss how it makes you feel that America, as a nation, has seemingly forsaken God’s rule over us and is going its own direction? Be honest.
6. Psalm 2:4 says that God laughs at this rebellion. Why does He laugh? What are your thoughts in regard to America being laughed at by God in this manner?
7. While it is sad what is happening to our nation, what kingdom should we ultimately be working for?
8. Read Psalm 46. What is the ultimate outcome of trusting in and being still before God even though the world is such a mess? *Hint: see verse 10*
