

## Life Group Discussion Material - Sunday, April 18<sup>th</sup> Message

<p>What Do I Believe? (Genesis 1-6) <i>Answers for Today from the Old Testament</i></p>

1. Do you believe that God's word, the Bible, is still relevant today? Why or why not?
2. Read Genesis 1:1-31 together. When you read this account, especially verses such as 5, 8, 13, 19, 23, and 31, what does it make you think about the period of time in between each day? Does it make you think about a day as we know it or something longer?
3. Do you believe that the days of creation were literal, 24-hour days? Why or why not?
4. What would be the implication if someone were to deny the account of creation as stated in the Bible? What would this do to the Scriptures as a whole?
5. Read Genesis 1:27 and discuss the significance of this verse. What does "created in the image of" mean?
6. Knowing that God highly values human life, discuss how mankind has not shared this same view.
7. We have seen a drastic change in the world's view of sexuality in the last decade. Why do you think the world has such a skewed view? For example, why does mankind have a problem determining gender all of a sudden?
8. Where does the moral code in your heart / mind come from?  
Read Genesis 2:16-17
9. Read Genesis 3:6. Who is to blame for sin? How might this change a person's mindset who gets angry at God for all of the evil in the world?
