<p>Isaiah 42:5-9 <i>Why Prophecy Matters</i></p>

1. Before this sermon series started, what was your view of Bible prophecy? What was the first thing that you thought of when you heard the term “prophecy?”
2. After only two weeks of the series, has your view of prophecy changed? If so, how?
3. How does prophecy present the divine origin of Scripture?
4. Read Jeremiah 10:12 and Isaiah 40:28-31. How or what do these prophetic verses teach us about God? Have you viewed prophetic verses in this way before?
5. Prophecy is often viewed as a lot of “doom and gloom.” One of the main points in today’s message was that “prophecy creates hope.” Read Revelation 21:4. This is perhaps one of the best hope producing prophecies in Scripture. Discuss the hope that it gives to you.
6. Have you ever thought of prophecy as an evangelistic tool? How did the video that was played today impact you in regard to prophecy being used in this way? How could you use Isaiah 53 as an evangelistic tool?
7. Pastor Jesse has said that we should not avoid prophecy since it is contained in such a large portion of the Scriptures. That being said, where do you find yourself on the “scale” of studying the prophetic writings of Scripture?
