BUILDING COMMITTEE REPORT: The committee continues to organize and handle the various preconstruction requirements. A good portion of those obligations have been completed such as soil testing, permitting, and topographical surveying among others. We are actively looking for a General Contractor and have approached several to date. It is expected to soon have one on board. In addition to their coordination and overseeing of construction activities, it is urgent that we have one in place soon so to get on work schedules of both theirs, and all other subcontractors. Timetables for all contractors are already getting filled for next year. We'll announce the hire of a general contractor as soon as that decision is made. Our committee is encouraged and excited about the recent progress that has been made. Also, thanks to everyone that contributed towards the 'Fill the Bin' campaign! Around \$75,000 was raised as a result.
